

Your unwavering support for ending money bond undoubtedly played an important role in the legislature's recent passage of the historic Pretrial Fairness Act. Now that this landmark legislation has arrived on your desk, we urge you to sign it into law and officially make Illinois the first state in the country to completely abolish money bond, a reform your administration named as one of its top priorities just over one year ago.

The use of money bond creates a two-tiered justice system where only those with wealth are granted their constitutional presumption of innocence. Every year, over 250,000 Illinoisans languish in jail pretrial while they are legally presumed innocent. Countless numbers of your constituents have lost their housing, jobs, and even custody of their children all because they could not afford to buy their freedom.

The archaic system of money bond and our overreliance on pretrial incarceration destabilizes people's lives and our communities, making us all less safe—but you have the opportunity to change that. By signing the Pretrial Fairness Act into law, you can eradicate one of the key drivers of mass incarceration and honor the dignity of so many people whose lives have been devastated by pretrial jailing.
